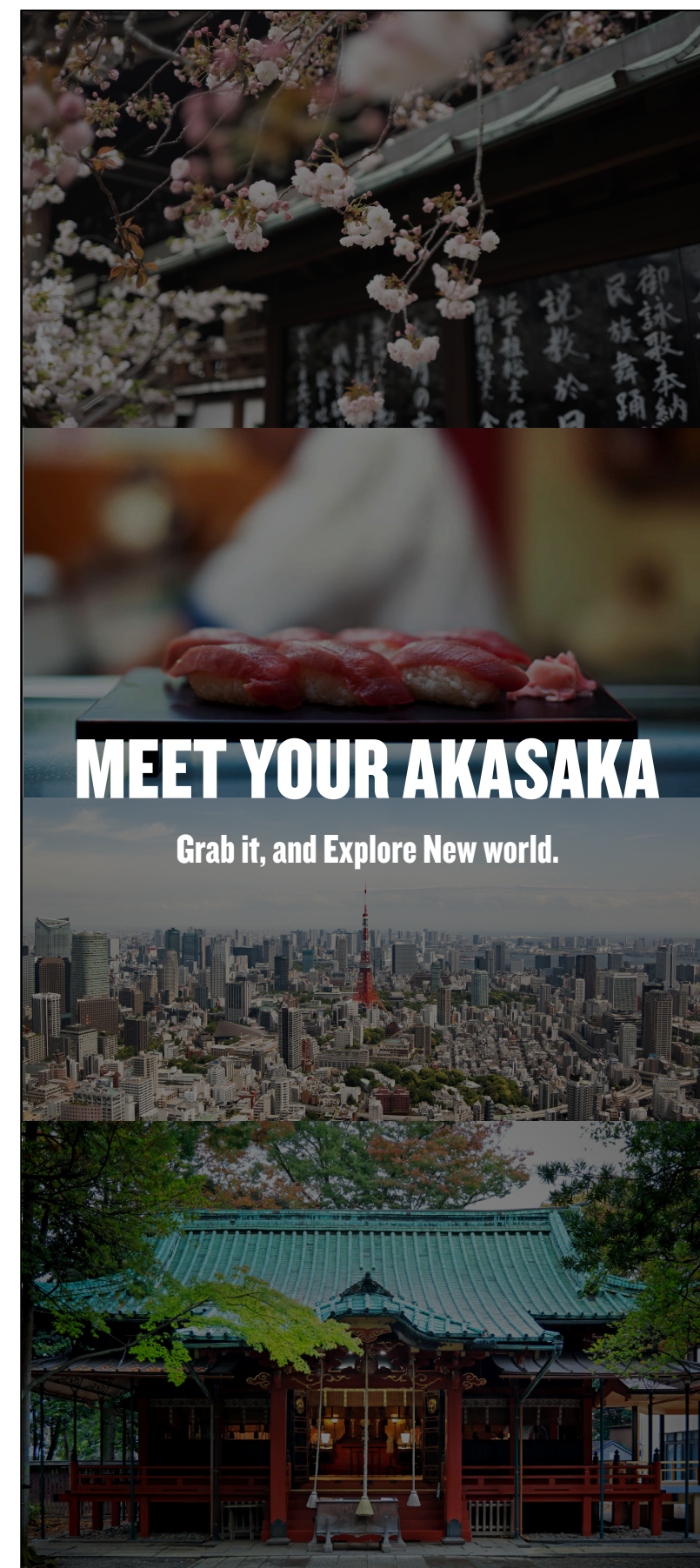

-So mysterious temple with 1000 foxes and worship them as god. /1-4-7 Motoakasaka

-A tourist-friendly shopping center for shopping, eating and lodging, directly connected to the hotel. /2-14-3 Nagatacho

Toraya

-Reopened after renovation in 2018. One of the traditional Wagashi shore. /4-9-22 Akasaka /The 6th of each month, except December.

-Their charm called "Yoriso Mamori (means 'live together') has a good reputation among Japanese couples. /8-11-27 Akasaka

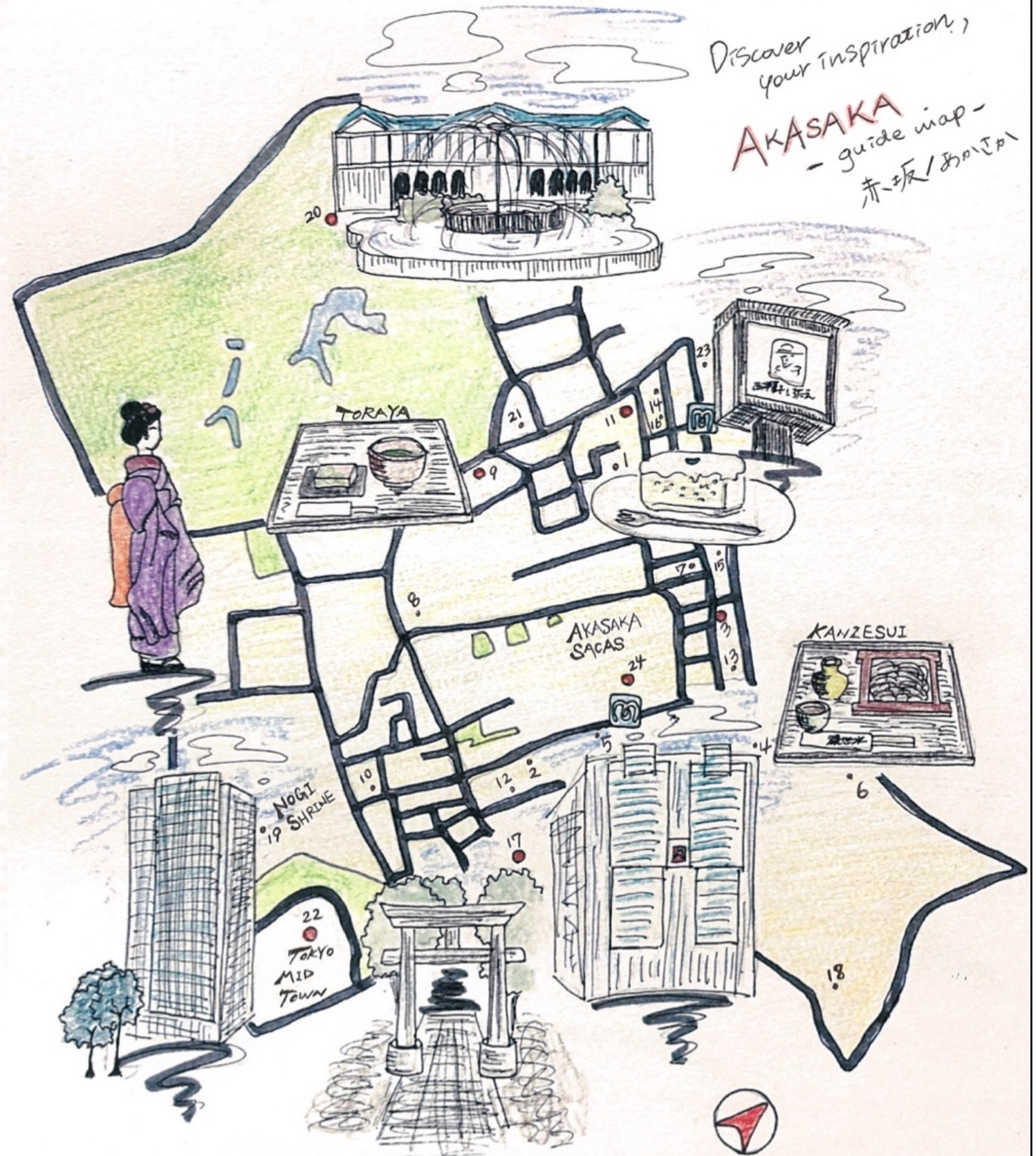
Akasaka Sacas
